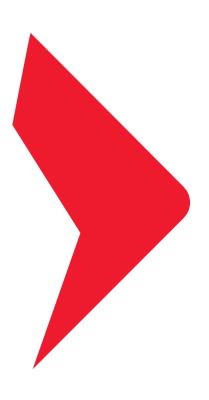

# Money market review and outlook

February 2023



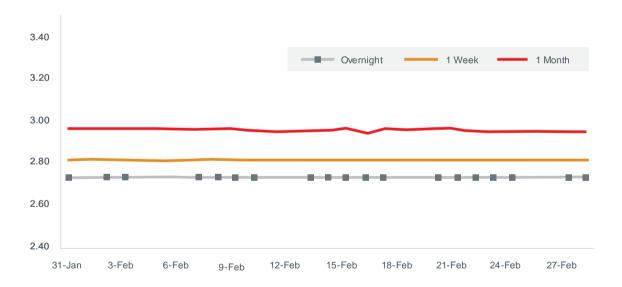
# **Review**

- Short-term interbank rates remained relatively stable with the overnight and 1-week rates traded at 2.73% to 2.81%, while the 1-month rates were dealt at 2.94% to 2.96%.
- In the short-term Bills market, yields across all tenures rose marginally by 1-3bps. Both 1-month and 12-month Bills closed the month at 2.77% and 3.14% respectively.

# **Outlook**

Short-term interbank rates are well supported by BNM, overall domestic financial conditions remained stable with strong capital and liquidity buffers. Rates to trend higher only upon further OPR adjustments.
